**Views**



Views are a powerful feature in Clue where you can decide how records in a Register are presented.

Each Register has a System View and the data displayed cannot be changed.

However, you can create your own View(s) for each Register, and save it as your default, to display fields relevant to you for easy access and visibility.

To create your own View, click on the "Add New View" option or the Advanced Options +

You can customise your View to include or exclude the content you want to include in a search, the filters you want to apply and the Columns(fields) to display

NB you will see all available data points on the Register – if you do not have access to the field/data or it is not captured, it will simply be empty

## Content in a Search

If both options are unchecked or checked, then all records and uploaded attachments are searched

**Filters** can be applied to a View to only show records that meet the criteria. This example will only show records where the Record Status equals Active.

You can add multiple filters and logic – i.e. all filters have to be met or one or the other.

This example will show records created after the 29th September and Assigned to Miranda.

By changing this to 1 OR 2 – it would show any record created after 29th September or any record assigned to Miranda.

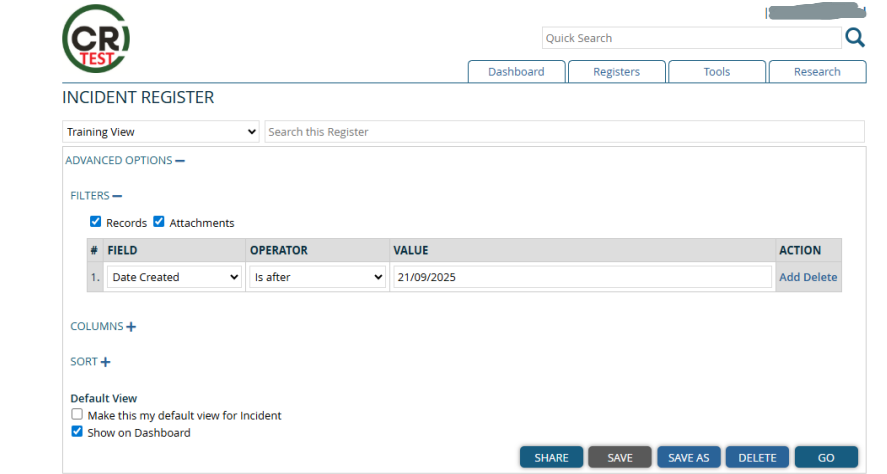
## Sharing a View

You can share a View you have created if you think it will be useful for a colleague or team.

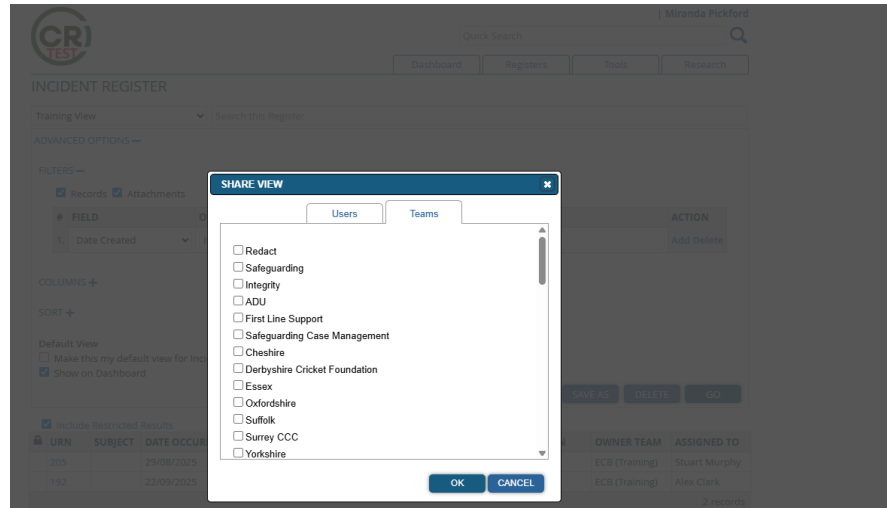
Click on Share and it will open all Users in Clue or toggle to Teams, you can select multiple from the list.

It will appear in their list of Views in the drop down, however they will not be alerted and they would have to add it to their Dashboard

NB If you edit or delete your View – it does not apply those changes to their View

When you log into Clue your Dashboard will give you access to the data most important to you – but it needs to be customised first.

Click on the Dashboard tab.

Views created in Registers can be pinned to the Dashboard so records from multiple Registers can be viewed on one screen

If the Dashboard is blank, then no Views have been added to the Dashboard.

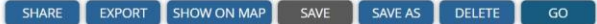
